Abstract: The manuscript should contain an abstract. The abstract should be self-contained and citation-free and should not exceed 150 words.

Keywords: Add about four key words or phrases in alphabetical order, separated by commas.

The paper must be written in English. The text should be written single-spaced, 12 point type, Tims New Roman. Fields: 2-2-2-2. The paper should include sections: introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusion, references. The article can include images and tables. The total volume of paper with figures, tables and references should not exceed 8 pages.

Acknowledgments: All acknowledgments (if any) should be included at the very end of the manuscript before the references and may include supporting grants, presentations, and so forth.

References: Authors are responsible for ensuring that the information in each reference is complete and accurate. All references must be numbered consecutively and citations of references in text should be identified using numbers in square brackets (e.g., "as discussed by Smith [9]"; "as discussed elsewhere [9, 10]"). All references should be cited within the text; otherwise, these references will be automatically removed.

Tables: All tables should be numbered with Arabic numerals. Headings should be placed above tables, underlined and centred. Leave one line space between the heading and the table. Only horizontal lines should be used within a table, to distinguish the column headings from the body of the table. Tables must be embedded into the text and not supplied separately.
